



**NOTICE OF TERMINATION
 OF A GENERAL OR INDIVIDUAL NPDES PERMIT
 FOR STORMWATER DISCHARGES ASSOCIATED WITH
 CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES
 - OR -
 FOR AN EROSION AND SEDIMENT PERMIT**

Applicability: This form may be used by those permittees or co-permittees who are presently covered under an Individual NPDES permit for discharges of stormwater associated with construction activities, the Pennsylvania General NPDES permit for discharges of stormwater associated with construction or an Erosion and Sediment Permit that was submitted after November 19, 2010.

Who may file a Notice of Termination (NOT) form:													
Permittees or Co-permittees who are presently covered under one of the above named permits may submit an NOT form when any earth disturbance activity or discharge associated with construction activity at the site has been terminated and the site has been stabilized. For construction activities, elimination of all stormwater discharges occurs when disturbed soils at the construction site have been stabilized, temporary erosion control BMP's have been removed, and permanent post construction stormwater management BMPs (where necessary) have been installed or site restoration or reclamation is complete.

The permittee shall retain a copy of the record drawings. Additional copies of this form and the record drawings must be provided to the local municipality and the person(s) identified in this NOT as being responsible for the long-term operation and maintenance for PCSM BMPs.

5. **CERTIFICATION (To be completed by person(s) listed in Section 3):**

I certify under penalty of law that all discharges associated with earth disturbance activities at the site that are authorized by the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Stormwater Construction permit or Erosion and Sediment Permit identified in Section 1 above have been eliminated, the site has been stabilized and Post Construction Stormwater Management BMPs have been installed. I also understand that the submittal of the Notice of Termination does not release a permittee from liability for any violations of this permit or of the federal Clean Water Act, the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law and the regulations promulgated pursuant thereto or from liability for any environmental damages occurring as a result of any earth disturbance activities conducted at the site. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations.

6. **Proof of filling of instrument with recorder of deeds:**

Note: The instrument filed with the recorder of deeds must assure disclosure of the PCSM BMP and related obligations in the ordinary course of a title search of the subject property. In addition, the recorded instrument must:

- A. Identify the PCSM BMP;
- B. Provide for necessary access related to long-term operation and maintenance for PCSM BMPs; and
- C. Provide notice that the responsibility for the long-term operation and maintenance of the PCSM BMP is a covenant that runs with the land that is binding upon and enforceable by subsequent grantees.

For Commonwealth-owned property, a covenant that runs with the land is not required until the transfer of the land containing the PCSM BMP. Upon transfer of the Commonwealth-owned property containing a PCSM BMP, the deed must comply with the conditions in 102.8(m)(2).
